- Children aged 3–4 years must have experience being in a classroom setting without a parent/guardian present.
- Even if you register your child for the same classes in Week 1 and Week 2, the projects will change, so join us for both weeks!
- Students are responsible for their own, peanut-free lunches and snacks. Participants 13 years and older will not be supervised during lunch break.
- For safety reasons, students require a basic understanding of English.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Acting for the Camera

This class develops on-camera basics through improvisations and readings. Young actors hone auditioning techniques, building self-confidence, and self-awareness on- and off-camera.

Architecture

From skyscrapers to stadiums, hospitals to hotels—this class guides an understanding of architecture through observation, drawing, and model-making. Projects explore scale, proportion, volume, measurement, and creative construction techniques.

Art Start

Young imaginations dig into art history, fueling adventures in shape, colour, and pattern. Kids get their hands on watercolours, tempera paints, oil pastels, chalks, and paper collages.

Cartooning

Young artists invent images using coloured pencils, pastels, markers, and paper cut-outs. From funny faces and comical backgrounds to animals and monsters—this is creativity with no limits.

Classical Animation

Develop entertaining characters and make them move! Young animators share their imaginings, using a variety of media to create digital and animated masterpieces.

Computer Arts

Learning to use Photoshop, Flash, iMovie, and other software gives kids the skills to design and create web pages, animations, movies, and more. Plug in and get creative!

Creative Drama (5-6)

Children develop their imagination, creativity, and self-confidence with fun and exhilarating theatre games. Improvisation, miming, and movement are just the beginning.

Creative Drama (6-8)

Act out with improv, miming, and more! Fun theatre games help kids develop imagination, creativity, and self-confidence.

Drawing & Painting (3-4)

Get colourful! Young artists learn composition, design, and colour theory basics using charcoal, oil pastels, tempera, chalk, and pen and ink.

Drawing & Painting (5-6)

Kids explore composition, design, and colour theory with charcoal, oil pastels, tempera, chalk, and pen and ink as their tools.

Drawing & Painting (6-8)

Smokey charcoals, bright temperas and chalks, oil pastels, or pen and ink: colours and textures blend beautifully in this exploration of composition, design, and colour theory!

Drawing & Painting (9-12)

Hone visual perception, get inspired by abstract concepts or still life, and create interpretations using charcoal, oil pastel, tempera, chalk, and pen and ink. Students examine composition, design, colour, and art history in this fun class!

Drawing & Painting (13-19)

Go outside the lines. From abstracts to experiments, this half-day workshop lets students unleash their creativity and investigate colour, form, composition, line, and tone. Traditional and unusual drawing and painting materials all have a place in this busy art studio.

Dress Up Drama

Stories and myths from around the world inspire journeys into the landscape of imagination. Theatre games provide a stage for kids, who become fantastical creatures and characters with the help of Arts Umbrella's costume "tickle trunks."

Fine Art of Hanging Out

Grab your backpack (it's supplied with watercolours, pastels, conté pencils, sketch board, and paper) and explore Vancouver with an artist's eye! The class may head to beaches, parks, museums, galleries, or artist studios to create "en plein-air" (in the open air) artworks.

Hip Hop

Move to the music in Hip Hop class! Students think on their feet and dance their way through a study of rhythm, coordination, and choreography. Energizing and fast-paced, the class develops focus, strength, and agility without losing the beat of fun.

Kid Tech

Capture video on digital recorders and turn it into multi-media art and digital imagery. Kids expand their technical know-how with software such as Photoshop and iMovie.

Mixed Media & Painting

Study various art forms and explore sculptural design through traditional techniques and experimental methods. Students work with wood, paint, clay, papier mâché, and found objects to build their creations.

Mixed Media & Sculpture (3-4)

Our youngest Spring Break artists get their hands on inspiring studio materials and tools, creating 2- and 3-D art that explores colour, pattern, and texture.

Mixed Media & Sculpture (5-6)

Let imagination grow. Children create 2- and 3-D artworks, exploring colour, pattern, and texture. In a studio filled with exciting materials and tools, children turn original ideas into works of art.

Mixed Media & Sculpture (6-8)

Kids mix it up in unconventional ways with clay, wood, fabric, paper, and found objects to shape 2- and 3-D projects. Tempera, watercolour, pastel, chalk, and other materials are also tools in this study of pattern, texture, and colour.

Mixed Media & Sculpture (9-12)

Students use materials—from clay and wood to fabric and found objects—to shape 2- and 3-D projects. Tempera, watercolour, pastel, chalk, and more help young artists explore pattern, texture, and colour.

Movement in Play

Get moving and get expressive—the world of Theatre is revealed to kids in this fun and interactive class. Students go beyond texts to discover storytelling without words. Children learn technique, the relationship between the physical body and music, and ways of relating to each other and the world.

Musical Theatre

Sing, dance, act—Arts Umbrella is your stage! Our musical theatre repertoire features ensemble and solo pieces. Learn how to prep an audition and delve into vocal training, choreography, and improvisation.

Photography (10-12)

Look at Granville Island through a 35mm camera lens. Learn how a camera “sees,” and experiment with aperture, shutter speed, black-and-white film developing, contact printing, and enlarging. Build technical skills, discover historical processes, compose unique images, and then produce prints in our dedicated darkroom.

Photography (13-19)

You can't get this on an iPhone! Photographers explore Granville Island with a 35mm analog camera, building technical skills, and composing images. Learn how a camera “sees,” discover historical processes, and create prints in our darkroom. We cover aperture, shutter speed, black-and-white film developing, contact printing, and enlarging.

Shakespeare Shorts

Learn why the works of the immortal Bard Continue to be cherished and produced, How iambic pentameter can hold The key to making sense of famous texts. Uncover hidden gems in language old And fall in love with William Shakespeare's words.

Theatre Works

Theatre games encourage imagination, creativity, self-confidence, and self-awareness. Students connect through improvisation, mask, movement, and physical characterization. Be heard—work with breath and resonators in order to project your voice. If all the world's a stage and we are merely players, then let's play together and discover how “theatre works.”

At lunchtime

Students enrolled in full-day packages can be a part of the lunch hour. It's more than sandwiches and snacks: Arts Umbrella staff supervises the kids while they play with friends, share artwork, and take part in organized games.

1 Create an account: First, visit artsumbrella.com and create an online account. Need help? Give us a call at 604.681.5268.

2 Pick when: Granville Island camps run four or five days – March 13-17, 2017 (5 days) and March 20-24, 2017.

3 How old: Classes are divided up by age. Let us know how old your young artist will be when the program begins.

4 Mix and match: Pick a schedule to meet your needs. At Granville Island, you can choose a morning or afternoon program, or combine them for a full day camp.

5 Dropoffs and pickups: Early morning dropoff (8:30-9 am) and afternoon supervision (4-5 pm) are available for an additional fee. See schedules for details.

6 A helping hand: Finances shouldn't prevent any child from participating. We have a bursary fund that's open to all applications for full or partial subsidy. To apply: artsumbrella.com/bursary
