- Children ages 3-4 must have prior experience being in a classroom setting without a parent or guardian present.
- Younger artists might prefer to start with a half day. Please consider your child's comfort level before registering for a full day of classes.
- Projects differ in the morning and afternoon, and week to week.

- Students are responsible for their own peanut-free lunches and snacks.
- Participants aged 13 and older will not be supervised during lunch break.
- For safety reasons, students require a basic understanding of English.

Withdrawal Fees and Deadlines

A \$50 (full-day program) or \$25 (half-day program) fee applies for withdrawals made 48 hours or more before the program start date. A refund for the remaining balance will be issued.

No refunds will be issued for withdrawals made under 48 hours before program start date.

Illness or Injury

A pro-rated refund may be issued if your child is unable to attend classes and you have a signed physician's note.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Acting for the Camera

Develop your on-camera acting skills through exercises, readings, and improvisation. Young actors build self-confidence and self-awareness both on- and off-camera.

Architecture

Explore the building blocks of our world, from skyscrapers to stadiums, hospitals to hotels, and houses to public spaces. Students learn about architecture through observation, drawing, and model-making.

Art Start

Press GO on your child's journey with art. Young artists engage with shape, colour, pattern, and culture, while working with watercolours, tempera paint, oil pastels, chalks, and paper.

Cartooning

From the depths of your imagination to the blank page, create a character worthy of comic books. Young artists design cartoon characters, backgrounds, animals, and monsters using pencils, pastels, markers, and paper cut-outs.

Classical Animation

Bring your drawings to life with animation! From sketchbook to screen, young artists learn basic software skills to create digital animated masterpieces.

Computer Arts

Plug in and get creative! Kids get familiar with software like Photoshop, Flash, and iMovie—giving them the skills to create web pages, animations, movies, and more.

Creative Drama

Plant a seed. See it grow! Through theatre exercises like improv, miming, and movement, children develop their imagination, creativity, and self-confidence.

Digital Photography

Snap photos with know-how. Discover manual camera features such as aperture, shutter speed, and ISO, and apply that knowledge to take photos that unveil your unique artistic expression.

Drawing & Painting

Get inspired by abstract concepts or still life, and release that energy into new interpretations! Young artists hone their visual perception through the study of composition, design, colour, and art history, then apply their ideas to the page using charcoal, oil pastel, tempera, chalk, and pen and ink.

Dress Up Drama

Open a "tickle trunk" into the land of imagination! Stories from around the world provide a backdrop for kids to play fun theatre exercises. Beyond the excitement, children discover self-confidence and learn to work together with new friends.

Fine Art of Hanging Out

Grab a backpack and explore Vancouver with an artist's eye! With packs fully stocked with art supplies, and the van ready to go, students create artworks en-plain-air (in the open air) at places like the beach, parks, museums, galleries, or artist studios.

Graphic Novel & Comic Creation Intensive

Create your own comic! In this intensive, kids will create a graphic novel from start to finish, from character design and scriptwriting, to drawing technique and composition. Using pencils, paper, and brush pens to draw, students will then scan their completed work to set it up for print to bring home a unique creation!

Hip Hop

Get your groove on! Students dance their way through a study of rhythm, coordination, and choreography. Energizing and fast-paced, this class develops focus, strength, and agility, without losing a beat of fun.

Kid Tech

Get behind the camera and the screen! First, young videographers capture video on digital recorders, then they turn it into multi-media art and digital imagery. In the Mac lab, kids expand their technical know-how with software such as Photoshop and iMovie.

Making Music

Songs, movement, and stories bring music to life! This hands-on class is a fun, interactive way to introduce children to music fundamentals like melody, rhythm, and pitch. Kids use hand-held percussion instruments and learn to work as an ensemble

Mixed Media

Go beyond traditional materials! Study various art forms and explore design through traditional techniques and experimental methods. Students work with wood, paint, clay, and found objects to build unique creations.

Movement in Play

Get moving and get expressive—the world of theatre is revealed to kids in this fun and interactive class. Students go beyond texts to discover storytelling without words. Children learn technique, the relationship between the physical body and music, and ways of relating to one another and the world.

Musical Theatre

Sing, dance, act—you can do it all! At Arts Umbrella, repertoire features ensemble pieces so students learn to work as a team. Delve into vocal training, choreography, and improvisation.

Photography

You can't get this on a smartphone! Discover the history of photography—learn how a film camera works, discover historical processes, and create prints in our darkroom. Students explore Granville Island with a 35mm camera and build technical skills through practice and reflection.

Sculpture & Mixed Media

Shape something magical! Students shape 2-D and 3-D projects using clay, wood, fabric, paper, and found objects, as well as tempera, watercolours, pastels, and chalk. It all comes together in an exploration of colour, pattern, and texture

Shakespeare Shorts

Learn why the works of the immortal Bard Continue to be cherished and produced, How iambic pentameter can hold The key to making sense of famous texts. Uncover hidden gems in language old, and fall in love with William Shakespeare's words.

Theatre Works

Let's play together, and discover how "theatre works." Students connect through improvisation, mask, movement, and physical characterization. Theatre exercises encourage imagination, creativity, self-confidence, and self-awareness.

Youth Theatre Intensive

Places, please! Students learn to trust their theatre instincts and improve their rehearsal and performance skills through theatre exercises, character study, script work, and more. Young actors are empowered to access and make bold emotional and physical character choices.

LUNCHTIME

Students enrolled in full-day packages continue the fun during lunch hour. It's more than sandwiches and snacks— Arts Umbrella staff supervise the kids while they play with friends, share artwork, and take part in organized games.


