- Children ages 3-4 may only be registered for a half-day of camp and are not eligible for lunch supervision.
- Younger artists might prefer to start with a half day. Please consider your child's comfort level before registering for a full day of classes.
- Projects differ in the morning and afternoon, and week to week. Join us for all six weeks!
- Students are responsible for their own nut-free lunches and snacks.
- Participants ages 13 and older are able to arrive and leave camp unaccompanied by an adult.
- For safety reasons, students require a working understanding of English.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

See schedule pages to view class age options. Class exercises, techniques, and projects are age appropriate, adding complexity for older students.

Acting for the Camera

Develop your on-camera acting skills through exercises, readings, and improvisation. Young actors build self-confidence and selfawareness both on- and off-camera.

Art Start

Press GO on your child's journey with art. Young artists engage with shape, colour, pattern, and culture, while working with watercolours, tempera paint, oil pastels, chalks, and paper.

Cartooning

From the depths of your imagination to the blank page, create a character worthy of comic books. Young artists design cartoon characters, backgrounds, animals, and monsters using coloured pencils, pastels, markers, and paper cut-outs.

Classical Animation

Animate your stories! In this class, students learn classical animation basics like movement, pace, storyboarding, and flip-o-ramas. Youth create and develop characters, shape and move props, and draw backgrounds, all while getting a feel for different animation styles, including hand-drawn, cut-out, and object animation.

Computer Arts

Plug in and get creative! Kids get familiar with software like Photoshop, Flash, and iMovie giving them the skills to create web pages, animations, movies, and more.

Creative Dance

Discover movement! Percussion games and choreography encourage kids to express themselves through dance. Children also learn basic dance vocabulary, discover various dance styles, and develop focus.

Creative Drama

Plant a seed. See it grow! Through theatre exercises like improv, miming, and movement, children develop their imagination, creativity, and self-confidence.

Drawing & Painting

Get inspired by abstract concepts or still life, and release that energy into new interpretations! Young artists hone their visual perception through the study of composition, design, colour, and art history, then apply their ideas to the page using charcoal, oil pastel, tempera, chalk, and pen and ink.

Drawing, Painting & Printmaking

In a fun and engaging environment, young artists learn about monoprinting, caligraphs, and stenciling to create their own original works. Students also experiment with materials—like oil pastel, tempera paints, printing inks, and collage—and dig into famous artists' stories, discover historical influences, and examine works of fine art.

Drawing & Sketching Techniques

Graphite, India ink, charcoal, chalk, and oil pastel—this class helps young artists develop their technique in many media. Students experiment with styles—from traditional charcoal drawings to contemporary abstracts and produce new works using the foundation of art and design.

Dress Up Drama

Open a "tickle trunk" into the land of imagination! Stories from around the world provide a backdrop for kids to play fun theatre exercises. Beyond the excitement, children discover self-confidence and learn to work together with new friends.

Fine Art of Hanging Out

Grab a backpack and explore South Surrey/ White Rock with an artist's eye! With packs fully stocked with art supplies, and the van ready to go, students create artworks en-plein-air (in the open air) at places like beaches, parks, museums, galleries, or artist studios.

Graphic Novel & Comic Creation

Create your own comic! In this program, kids will create a graphic novel from start to finish, from character design and scriptwriting, to drawing technique and composition. Using pencils, paper, and brush pens to draw, students will then scan their completed work to set it up for print to bring home a unique creation!

Hip Hop

Get your groove on! Students dance their way through a study of rhythm, coordination, and choreography. Energizing and fast-paced, the class develops focus, strength, and agility, without losing a beat of fun.

Kid Tech

Kids love developing their ideas using art-based software. This class mashes up source material like original digital camera photos, Photo Booth shots, and digital downloads. Students will also record sound and explore their new understanding of animation techniques.

Mixed Media

Go beyond traditional materials! Study various art forms and explore design through traditional techniques and experimental methods. Students work with wood, paint, and found objects to build unique creations.

Musical Theatre

Sing, dance, act—you can do it all! At Arts Umbrella, repertoire features ensemble pieces so students learn to work as a team. Delve into vocal training, choreography, and improvisation.

Musical Theatre Intensive

Command the stage! Young performers work on group and solo pieces from the musical theatre canon. Through play-based teaching, students explore the intersection of dance, song, and acting. In-depth vocal and acting techniques are brought into focus as young people nurture their sense of self as a performing artist.

Theatre Works

Let's play together, and discover how "theatre works." Students connect through improvisation, mask, movement, and physical characterization. Theatre exercises encourage imagination, creativity, self-confidence, and self-awareness.
