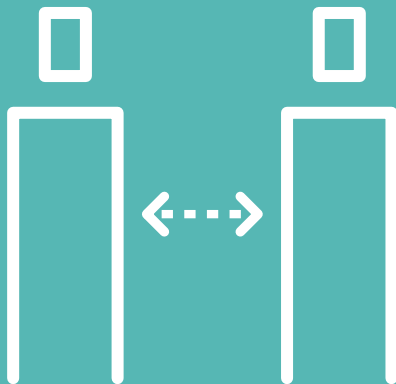




2020 HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES

CLEANING MEASURES

- Common area (including washrooms, elevators, and stairwells) will be cleaned hourly during peak times.
- Studios (including sinks, chairs, and ballet barres) will be cleaned after every class.
- Handwashing and sanitization will be required of students and staff.



PHYSICAL DISTANCING MEASURES

- In-person classes now have fewer students to accommodate physical distancing guidelines.
- Only students and staff will be permitted in the Arts Umbrella building. Don't worry! Door monitors will help direct students to their classes following outdoor drop-off.
- Floor markers and signs are placed throughout the building.
- There are dedicated up and down stairwells to control traffic flow.
- Physical barriers at front desk have been installed
- Washrooms and elevators have a capacity limit of one individual or family.
- Masks will only be required if physical distancing cannot be maintained.

HEALTH DECLARATION

- All Arts Umbrella staff have all completed a Health Check Declaration Waiver and Compliance Form before returning to work.
- Upon entering an Arts Umbrella facility, staff must acknowledge they have no symptoms of cold, flu, or COVID-19.
- To help prevent the spread of colds and viruses, all parents and/or guardians are required to complete a Student Health Declaration upon registration.



RECOMMENDATIONS

- To discourage students from touching their faces, we recommend tying long hair back.
- Bring water from home. Water fountains will not be accessible in the building.
- Don't wear your best clothes! Art smocks will not be provided.
