Select your child's age

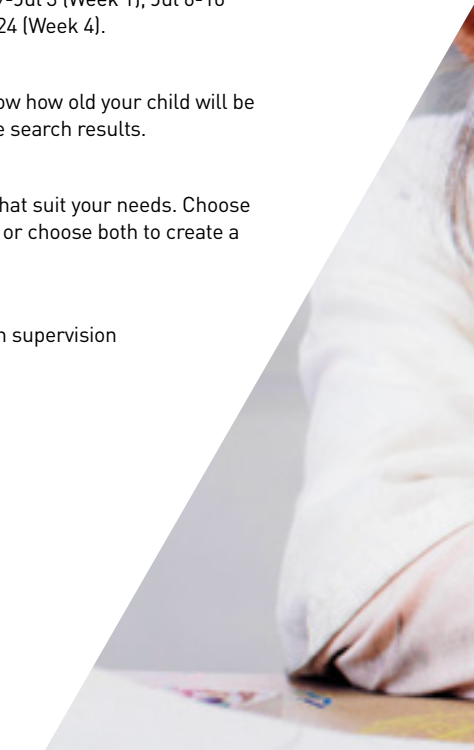
Classes are sorted by age. Let us know how old your child will be when the program begins to filter the search results.

Early morning drop-off and afternoon supervision are available for an additional fee.





GOOD TO KNOW

- Children ages 3-4 must be potty trained and must have prior experience being in a classroom setting without a parent or guardian present.
- Younger artists ages 3-4 may only register for a half day. For ages 5-6 please consider your child's comfort level before registering for a full day of classes. Please note early, lunch, and after care is not provided for 3-4 year olds.
- Projects differ in the morning and afternoon, and week to week. Join us for all four weeks!
- Students are responsible for their own nut-free lunches and snacks.
- Participants ages 13 and older are able to arrive and leave camp unaccompanied by an adult. 9-12 year olds are permitted to leave camp on their own only if their parents sign an Authorization Release Form.
- For safety reasons, students require a working understanding of English.

AFTERNOON CAMPS

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Class exercises, techniques, and projects are age appropriate, adding complexity for older students.

Acting for the Camera 6-8, 9-12

Young actors develop on-camera acting skills, self-confidence, and self-awareness through exercises, readings, and improvisation.

Acting on the Go 9-12, 13-19

Visit a commercial sound studio, spend time on a film set, and discover Vancouver through the eyes of an actor. Gain experience and comfort while exploring the acting industry through film and voice acting, site-specific theatre creation, improv, and experimenting with your own craft.

Acting for Theatre 9-12

Let's play together, and discover how theatre works. Students connect through improvisation, movement, and physical characterization. Theatre exercises encourage imagination, creativity, self-confidence, and self-awareness.

Architecture 6-8, 9-12, 10-12, 13-19

Explore the building blocks of our world, from skyscrapers to stadiums, houses to public spaces. Students learn about architecture through observation, drawing, and model-making.

Art Start 3-4

Press GO on your child's journey with art. Young artists engage with shape, colour, pattern, and culture, while working with watercolours, tempera paint, oil pastels, chalks, and paper.

Cartooning 6-8

From your mind to the page, create a character worthy of comic books. Participants design cartoon characters, backgrounds, and more using pencils, pastels, markers, and paper cut-outs.

Classical Animation 9-12

Bring your drawings to life with animation! Artists will learn basic animation techniques and skills to take their ideas from their sketchbook to the screen. Artists will learn basic software skills to create their digitally animated pieces.

Computer Arts 9-12

Plug in and get creative! Kids get familiar with software like Photoshop, Flash, and iMovie—giving them the skills to create websites, animations, movies, and more.

Creative Drama 5-6, 6-8

Act it out with improv, character, and more! In this beginner theatre camp, kids develop imagination, creativity, and self-confidence through fun theatre exercises.

Darkroom Photography, 10-12, 13-19

You can't get this on a smartphone! Discover the history of photography—learn how a film camera works, discover historical processes, and create prints in our darkroom. Students explore Granville Island with a 35mm camera and build technical skills through practice and reflection.

Digital Photography 10-12, 13-19

Snap photos with know-how. Discover DSLR camera features such as aperture, shutter speed, and ISO, and apply that knowledge to take photos that unveil your unique artistic expression.

Discovering Shakespeare 6-8, 9-12

Learn why the works of the immortal Bard Continue to be cherished and produced, How iambic pentameter can hold The key to making sense of famous texts. Uncover hidden gems in language old, and fall in love with William Shakespeare's words.

Drawing & Painting 5-6, 6-8, 9-12, 13-19

Get inspired by abstract concepts, still life, and celebrated artists. Participants hone their visual perception through the study of composition, colour, and art history, then apply their ideas to the page using charcoal, oil pastel, tempera, and ink.

Dress Up Drama 3-4

Open a “tickle trunk” into the land of imagination! Stories and myths from around the world provide a backdrop for kids to play fun theatre exercises. Children will discover self-confidence and learn to work together with new friends.

Fine Art of Hanging Out 6-8, 9-12, 13-19

Grab a backpack stocked with art supplies and explore Vancouver with an artist’s eye! Our van is ready to bring students to create artworks en plein air (in the open air) at locations around Vancouver.

Graphic Novel & Comic Creation 10-12, 13-19

Create your own comic! Artists can experience what it’s like to develop a graphic novel. From character design, scriptwriting, to drawing techniques and composition. Using traditional tools such as pens, pencils, and inks, students will learn the foundations and processes of comic creation.

Hip Hop 6-8, 9-12

Get your groove on! Students dance their way through a study of rhythm, coordination, and choreography, without losing the beat of fun.

Imagination Through Movement 5-6

Students learn to express themselves through physical theatre and a sense of play. Class activities may include mask, character creation, puppetry, and simple choreography to help promote coordination and self-confidence.

Kid Tech 6-8

Children are introduced to the computer by exploring their ideas using different software in this class. Students create digital art using original photos, Photo Booth shots, and digital downloads. Kids will also record sound and explore their new understanding of animation.

Making Music 3-4, 6-8

Songs, movement, and stories bring music to life! This hands-on class is a fun, interactive way to introduce children to music fundamentals like melody, rhythm, and pitch. Kids use hand-held percussion instruments and learn to work as an ensemble.

Mixed Media 5-6, 6-8, 9-12

Go beyond traditional materials! Study various art forms and explore design through traditional techniques and experimental methods. Students work with wood, paint, and found objects to build unique creations.

Movement in Play 5-6

The world of theatre is revealed to kids in this fun, interactive, and expressive class. Children learn new techniques, explore the relationship between the physical body and music, and discover ways of relating to one another and the world.

Musical Theatre 6-8, 9-12

Sing, dance, act—you can do it all! Students learn to work as a team through ensemble pieces. Let your inner star shine as you explore vocal training, choreography, and improvisation through Broadway musicals.



POLICIES

Withdrawals & Transfers

Withdrawal and transfer requests must be received in writing. Non-attendance or non-payment of outstanding fees does not constitute a formal withdrawal. Requests may be emailed to registration@artsumbrella.com, dropped off, or you may call 604.681.5268 x0.

Withdrawal Fees and Deadlines*

A \$50 (full-day program or intensive) or \$25 (half-day program) fee applies for withdrawals made two weeks or more before the program start date. A refund for the remaining balance will be issued. No refunds will be issued for withdrawals made under two weeks before program start.

**As of June 1, 2020, Arts Umbrella withdrawal fees will be changing. A 10% withdrawal fee will apply for all withdrawals made two weeks or less before the program start date.*

Illness or Injury

A pro-rated refund may be issued if your child is unable to attend classes and you have a signed physician's note.

Removal for Conduct
