Select your child's age


Classes are sorted by age. Let us know how old your child will be when the program begins to filter the search results.

GOOD TO KNOW

- Children ages 3-4 must be potty trained and must have prior experience being in a classroom setting without a parent or guardian present.
- Younger artists ages 3-4 may only register for half day. For ages 5-6 please consider your child's comfort level before registering for a full day of classes.
- Projects differ in the morning and afternoon, and week to week. Join us for all six weeks!
- Students are responsible for their own nut-free lunches and snacks.
- Participants ages 13 and older are able to arrive and leave camp unaccompanied by an adult. 9-12 year olds are permitted to leave camp on their own only if their parents sign an Authorization Release Form.
- For safety reasons, students require a working understanding of English.



CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Class exercises, techniques, and projects are age appropriate, with added complexity for older students.

Acting for the Camera 6-8, 9-12, 13-19

Young actors develop on-camera acting skills, self-confidence, and self-awareness through exercises, readings, and improvisation.

Acting for Theatre 9-12

Let's play together, and discover how theatre works. Students connect through improvisation, movement, and physical characterization. Theatre exercises encourage imagination, creativity, self-confidence, and self-awareness.

Art Start 3-5

Press GO on your child's journey with art. Young artists engage with shape, colour, pattern, and culture, while working with watercolours, tempera paint, oil pastels, chalks, and paper.

Cartooning 6-8

From your mind to the page, create a character worthy of comic books. Participants design cartoon characters, backgrounds, and more using pencils, pastels, markers, and paper cut-outs.

Classical Animation 9-12

Bring your drawings to life with animation! Artists will learn basic animation techniques and skills to take their ideas from their sketchbook to the screen. Artists will learn basic software skills to create their digitally animated pieces.

Computer Animation 9-12, 13-19

Students bring their drawings to life with animation tools and programs. They'll learn topics like frame rate, timelines, and the process of frame-by-frame animation as they work through this week-long camp.

Computer Arts 9-12

Plug in and get creative! Kids get familiar with software like Photoshop, Flash, and iMovie—giving them the skills to create websites, animations, movies, and more.

Creative Dance 3-5

Discover movement! Percussion games and choreography encourage kids to express themselves through dance. Children also learn basic dance vocabulary, discover various dance styles, and develop focus.

Creative Drama 4-6, 6-8

Act it out with improv, character, and more! In this beginner theatre camp, kids develop imagination, creativity, and self-confidence through fun theatre exercises.

Digital Photography 13-19

Snap photos with know-how. Discover DSLR camera features such as aperture, shutter speed, and ISO, and apply that knowledge to take photos that unveil your unique artistic expression.

Drawing & Painting 4-6, 6-8, 9-12, 13-19

Get inspired by abstract concepts, still life, and celebrated artists. Participants hone their visual perception through the study of composition, colour, and art history, then apply their ideas to the page using charcoal, oil pastel, tempera, and ink.

Drawing, Painting & Printmaking 4-6, 6-8, 9-12

Young artists learn about monoprinting, collagraphs, and stenciling to create their own original works. Students also experiment with materials—like oil pastel, printing inks, and collage—and dig into famous artists' stories, and examine works of fine art.

Drawing & Sketching Techniques 9-12

Graphite, India ink, charcoal, chalk, and oil pastel—this class helps young artists develop their technique in many media. Students experiment with styles—from traditional charcoal drawings to contemporary abstracts—and produce new works.

Dress Up Drama 3-5

Open a “tickle trunk” into the land of imagination! Stories and myths from around the world provide a backdrop for kids to play fun theatre exercises. Children will discover self-confidence and learn to work together with new friends.

Film Acting Intensive 13-19

Take your acting to the next level as you join a group of like-minded teens and get experience working on-camera. Hone your scene work and explore what it means to work on a film set. Learn how to be in the moment, how to surprise yourself in your work, and hone your audition techniques for film and television.

Fine Art of Hanging Out 9-12

Grab a backpack stocked with art supplies and explore Surrey and White Rock with an artist’s eye! Our van is ready to bring students to create artworks en plein air (in the open air) at locations around Surrey and White Rock.

Graphic Novel & Comic Creation 9-12

Create your own comic! Kids will create a graphic novel from start to finish, from character design and scriptwriting, to drawing technique and composition. Using pencils, paper, and brush pens to draw, students will then scan their completed work, print it, and bring home a finished creation!

Hip Hop 4-6, 6-8, 9-12

Get your groove on! Students dance their way through a study of rhythm, coordination, and choreography, without losing the beat of fun.

Kid Tech 6-8

Children are introduced to the computer by exploring their ideas using different software in this class. Students create digital art using original photos, Photo Booth shots, and digital downloads. Kids will also record sound and explore their new understanding of animation.

Mixed Media & Sculpture 4-6, 6-8, 9-12

Go beyond traditional materials! Study various art forms and explore design through traditional techniques and experimental methods. Students work with wood, paint, and found objects to build unique creations.

Musical Theatre 4-6

Sing, dance, act—you can do it all! Students learn to work as a team through ensemble pieces. Let your inner star shine as you explore vocal training, choreography, and improvisation through Broadway musicals.

Musical Theatre 9-12

Sing, dance, and act—take a deep dive into the Musical Theatre trifecta! Command the stage with song, dance, and emotion. Students learn to match pitch, blend, and harmonize, while also exploring choreography and breath work. Through play-based teaching, students get more comfortable on stage and with each other as they nurture their sense of self as a performing artist.



POLICIES

Withdrawals & Transfers

Withdrawal and transfer requests must be received in writing. Non-attendance or non-payment of outstanding fees does not constitute a formal withdrawal.

Withdrawal & Transfer Fees and Deadlines*

A \$50 (full-day program) or \$25 (half-day program) fee applies for withdrawals made two weeks or more before the program start date. A refund for the remaining balance will be issued. No refunds will be issued for withdrawals made under two weeks before program start.

Transfers may be done up to 48 hours or more before the program start date, without penalty. No transfers will be accepted under 48 hours before program start date.

**As of June 1, 2020, Arts Umbrella withdrawal fees will be changing. A 10% withdrawal fee will apply for all withdrawals made two weeks or less before the program start date.*

Illness or Injury

A pro-rated refund may be issued if your child is unable to attend classes and you have a signed physician's note.

Removal for Conduct

Arts Umbrella reserves the right to remove any student who fails to comply with our student code of conduct. In such an event, fees for the complete program are due in full.
