- Canadian students must provide SIN number. Bursary awards exceeding \$500 per calendar year will be issued a T4A for tax purposes in compliance with Canada Revenue Agency requirements.
- Proof of income for all adult members in your household. (ie most recent notice of assessment)
- A letter to support your application (if applicable)
