Qualifying Applicants

Qualifying applicants are those who:

- 1. Will be graduated from secondary school with a Dogwood Diploma by August 31st, 2018.
- 2. Are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents.
- 3. Demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- 4. Will be pursuing full time studies in an approved post-secondary program in the creative sector.

Some students plan to take a "gap year" before pursuing post-secondary studies for varying reasons (i.e. work to raise funds or travel). Students who are planning to take a "gap year" to prepare for post-secondary are still eligible to apply for the scholarship as long as:

- 1. The gap year does not exceed the length of one academic year (i.e. September 2018-August 2019)
- 2. The student can still provide proof of enrollment at their chosen post-secondary institution.
- 3. The student can provide their reasoning for the gap year in their written statement.

Funds from the scholarship will be used towards supporting the student's time while enrolled in a program and actively taking classes.

Maintaining Eligibility

If successful in receiving the CPL Scholarship, the recipient will be expected to complete a report at the end of each academic year to maintain eligibility. In order to maintain eligibility, recipients of the scholarship will be expected to remain in good academic standing at their chosen institution, pursue full time studies each semester (unless less than a full time course load is needed for the last semester before graduation), and show a responsible use of scholarship funds through a reasonable application of their proposed budget.
