# **Qualifying Applicants**

Qualifying applicants are those who:

- Will be graduated from secondary school with a Dogwood Diploma.
- Are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents.
- Demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- Will be pursuing full time studies in an approved post-secondary program in the creative sector.
- Have a minimum of six months involvement in an Arts Umbrella program

Funds from the scholarship will be used towards supporting the student's time while enrolled in a program and actively taking classes.
