About Arts Umbrella

Arts Umbrella is where young artists ages 2–22 cultivate their creativity in Dance, Theatre, and Visual Arts. As a non-profit organization for arts education, we believe that art is powerful. Powerful enough to change kids' lives in incredible ways. When young people connect with the arts, they gain self-confidence, develop self-discipline, and discover creative expression—things they carry with them for life. Arts Umbrella has four locations in Vancouver and Surrey, as well as donor-funded programs at schools, community centres, neighbourhood houses, and healthcare facilities across Metro Vancouver. We reach close to 21,000 students every year, with nearly 80% participating at little to no cost.

Recently celebrating our 40th year, Arts Umbrella will be moving into the South Building of the former Emily Carr University of Art + Design on Granville Island in April 2021. This exceptional opportunity will allow Arts Umbrella to further our vision for a better world where all young lives are inspired to pursue a lifelong journey towards self-expression, compassion, and humanity. It is our mission to be Canada's leader in arts education for young people; to build community and deliver profound life experiences through our commitment to innovation, excellence, and inclusivity. Arts Umbrella ("AU") is an organization full of heart, where self-expression and creativity are valued and nurtured.

The Opportunity

Reporting to the Senior Director, Programming, the Artistic Director, Art & Design is responsible for creating and implementing the artistic vision and mandate of Art & Design programming at Arts Umbrella. The Artistic Director oversees Art & Design programming while also leading day to day activities of the Art & Design department, all with an eye to supporting the organization's strategic plan. The Artistic Director, Art & Design is based out of AU's Granville Island facility, but is also responsible for Art & Design programming at AU's two locations in Surrey, in addition to community programs being delivered at partner facilities. The Artistic Director, Art & Design leads a small administrative team as well as a large roster of approximately 100 part-time faculty.

Key Accountabilities:

- Provides leadership in developing relevant and engaging programming for a wide range of ages and skill levels, from Early Learners to ages 6-19, entry level to advanced
- Based on a wide scope of knowledge and experience, provides artistic direction in areas including Animation, Architecture, Clay Sculpture, Drawing & Painting, Media Arts, Mixed Media and more
- Ensures the successful implementation and continued development of AU's Art & Design curriculum within programming at all AU locations and community partner locations
- Supports the recruitment and retention of Art & Design staff
- Provides day to day supervision, coaching and mentoring of Art & Design staff (administrative and faculty) in collaboration with the Senior Director, Programming, Director, Community Programs, and/or Manager, Program Operations
- Supports student recruitment and retention efforts, providing leadership in admissions for advanced programs
- Develops relationships within the larger Art & Design community, identifying opportunities for AU programs (e.g. Visual Arts Summer Intensive with the Contemporary Art Gallery, Art Exchange with Vancouver Art Gallery)



- Works within the parameters of the annual operating plan to meet growth targets, including new program development
- As a member of the artistic management team, contributes to strategic planning and implementation through articulating artistic and programming objectives
- Instructs Art & Design classes, providing student mentorship, as required
- Collaborates with various departments and artistic disciplines at AU, including but not limited to Dance,
 Theatre, Fund Development, and Marketing
- Develops and manages department annual budget and schedule/program mix in partnership with Senior Director, Programming, Manager, Program Operations, and Director, Community Programs

As a leader for our artistic team, our ideal candidate has the ability to influence and lead others towards a clear direction while mentoring and coaching the instructional team to deliver excellence in programming.

- Strong knowledge of best practices and current trends in Art & Design pedagogy
- Minimum three years' experience as an Artistic Director in a visual arts, media arts and/or design environment with a proven ability to lead towards a strong artistic vision
- Minimum two years' experience leading an administrative team of two or more people
- Minimum two years' experience instructing young artists in any related discipline
- Minimum two years' experience recruiting, managing, and coaching instructors in their work teaching young artists
- Experience in building collaborative community partnerships and relationships integral to maintaining Arts Umbrella's place in the broader community
- Highly developed communication skills, both written and oral
- · Advanced interpersonal skills, able to relate and interact with multiple stakeholders, including children
- Experience exercising budget and project management skills
