## **Submission Guidelines: Tips and Tricks**

All Advanced classes are designed specifically for students who have demonstrated control and understanding of the elements and principles of art and design. These classes offer focused explorations of specific disciplines in a supportive environment that emphasizes ongoing mentorship, feedback, and critique. This base knowledge as well as the willingness to continue to develop your skills should be clearly demonstrated in your portfolio and letter of intent.

## Top Tips

- 1. Make sure to send a <u>complete submission package</u> (including completed application form, portfolio, and letter of intent). It is more difficult to review your submission without all the necessary contextual information.
- 2. Aim to include high resolution photos of your work, and title them in the order you'd like us to view them (eg. 01.Artist Name\_Title of Work.jpg, 02.Artist Name\_Title of Work.jpg etc)

## Portfolio

This is your chance to show us who you are as an artist! Don't hesitate to show us a range of work in a variety of mediums, but do try and gear your portfolio towards the program you are applying to. Including program specific work helps our jury gauge the level of skill and knowledge you bring to the class and gives us a better sense of your suitability to the program itself. Ex. A Clay Sculpture application should absolutely highlight your work with clay, but including paintings or drawings, or other work, is encouraged.

Your work should also show a fundamental grasp of the basics of visual art. You should aim to demonstrate control and understanding of the elements and principles of art and design including use of colour, shading, line, pattern, texture, composition, and balance. Ideally, this is shown through work that is mostly self-directed and not exclusively from Arts Umbrella or other school related projects. (Hint: your sketchbook is an excellent place to experiment with new materials and tools, sketch out concepts and ideas, or engage in deep studies of colour, composition, line, and pattern etc.)

#### Letter of Intent

We read this carefully, so please make sure to spend time expressing who you are and why you want to join this program. We are looking to make sure you understand what this program actually entails and why you are suitable for it. We also want to know how you in particular will benefit and what you will bring as a participant. It's also a great space to provide more information on the images we're looking at in your portfolio!
