Skilled in interacting with diverse groups of people and operate well in a collaborative work environment while remaining upbeat and courteous. We are looking for someone with solid experience in Microsoft Office, which is detail oriented, extremely organized, and knowledgeable in visual arts practices. A post-secondary degree or diploma plus one to two years of work experience or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience is preferred.
