2. Letter of Intent:

Your letter must be between 500-1000 words, or roughly one page, in length. In your letter, please tell us why you are interested in this program, what you will bring, and how you will benefit from the experience. Please include a brief statement about the work in your portfolio.

3. Portfolio:

Submit 3 examples (limited to 3 minutes only, viewable by a YouTube or Vimeo link) of your best animation or multi-media work showing us your computer skills and representative of your artistic practice.

Additionally, please submit 5-7 images in JPEG format, no larger than 1MB each, that show the full span of your creativity and storyboarding (a sequence of drawings, typically with some directions and dialogue, representing shots planned for a movie, animation, or television production).

If there are barriers to submitting a digital portfolio, please contact us to make alternative arrangements.
